Membership and other Participation List by name, year, and approximate time commitment for each school, community, and volunteer activities. *Example:* Yearbook Staff (10,11, college) 25 hrs. a month for 6 months. Basketball (9,10,11,12, college) 40 hrs a month for 3 months.

Leadership Positions and Offices List by name, years held, and approximate time commitment for each school, community and volunteer activity. *Example:* Student Council Representative (9,10,11,12) 12 hrs. each month for 5 months. 4-H Leader (11,12, college) 5 hrs. each month for 4 months.

Honors and/or Awards List by name and year received. *Example:* All Conference Basketball (11, college). Boys/Girls State (11). Jr. Rotarian (10).

Volunteer Work Positions List by name, year, and approximate time commitment. *Example:* Candy Striper (11,12, college) 20 hrs. a month for 3 months. Bible School Teacher (12) 4 hours a day for one week.

Paid Work Positions List by name, year, and approximate hours worked. *Example:* Grocery Store (11,12, college) 16 hrs. a month for 2 months. McDonald's (10,11,12, college) 20 hrs. a month for 4 months.

Indiana NAPUS Retired Members must be current dues paying members and must have been a continuing dues paying member until deceased. Associate Members must be a current dues paying member and must have been a continuing dues paying member of the Indiana Chapter of NAPUS for a minimum of three years.
- All information submitted becomes the property of the Scholarship Committee and will be held in strict confidence.
- Applications must be postmarked by March 15 of the year of the application.
- Applicants who are awarded scholarships will be expected to attend the Grand Banquet held at the Indiana NAPUS State Convention as a guest of the chapter to accept their scholarship.
